

Royal Mail services on Monday 19 September suspended for the Funeral of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II

The close relationship between the monarch and the British postal service has endured for more than 500 years, ever since King Henry VIII appointed the very first postmaster. We want to make our customers aware that services will be suspended on the day of the funeral as people come together to honour Her Majesty,

after 70 years of exemplary service to the nation and the Commonwealth."
